

REFLECTION IDEAS – Jesus, the Servant

John chapter 13 verses 1 to 17; Mark chapter 10 verses 43 to 45

So much we read and hear can seem to point to us getting what we can out of life. Looking out for ourselves. The recordings of Jesus in the Bible seem to point us to a different way to live.

Inspire Prayer Space Activity – Do you put others first?

Putting other people first, and recognising that your needs may not be the most important, shows humility. The Bible tells of many times Jesus showed humility. In John 13 he washed the feet of his friends, the disciples. This would have been a dirty job and not one usually done by someone like Jesus. Have you ever offered to do a job or a task that no one else wants to do?

Talk with someone near you and see if you can come up with some suggestions of things you can do, that will show humility. By doing one of these, you are showing that you are thinking of others. Choose one to do today or tomorrow. You may like to say a prayer to God to ask him to help you look for ways to show humility.



Some suggestions of things might be:

- to offer to help tidy up at home;
- to allow a sibling to have their pick first, before you;
- find a way to show your teacher you are thankful for all they do;
- going out of your way to make sure all are included in games on the playground.
