REFLECTION IDEAS – Jesus, the Miracle Worker



Jesus turns water into wine - John chapter 2 verses 1 to 11. Other miracles – Luke ch 8 vs 22-25 and Mark ch 4 vs 35-41; Luke ch 9 vs 10-17 and John ch 6 vs 1-13.

The Bible has many examples of dramatic events occurring that are called miracles. In the New Testament of the Bible Jesus did miracles to help people when they were in difficulty. Christians believe that when we pray Jesus can help us in the difficulties we face today.

Reflection

- What does Jesus' miracle of changing water into wine tell us about him? Think about what motivated him and how he helped.
- How do you think you would have felt if you were at the wedding and saw what Jesus did?
- Jesus helped people in difficulty. Is there anything you are finding difficult right now? If you want to, you could ask Jesus to help you.

Inspire Prayer Space Activity – Miracle Smiles

Equipment

- Squares of coloured paper
- Pencils / crayons / pens (not water soluble)
- Bowl of water.

Description

Jesus did miracles to help people, to turn make difficult or hard situations better. This activity encourages us to think about something we might need help with.

Instructions


Think of something that might be difficult for you or someone else at the moment, something that you might need help with.

- 1. Draw a smiley face in the middle of the square of paper.
- 2. Fold all of the corners into the middle of the paper, covering up the smiley face.
- 3. Draw a sad face on top of the folds of paper.
- 4. Put the paper into a bowl of water.

As you watch the folds open to get rid of the sad face and reveal the smiley face, think of the difficult situation

being made better. If you want to you could ask Jesus to help.

Colour and cut out the five pictures of the story of Jesus helping the people at a wedding in Cana, by turning water in to wine.


Copy or stick the correct set of words next to each picture to tell the story.
