REFLECTION IDEAS – Choice, Easter 2025



Matthew chapter 27 verse 57 to chapter 28 verse 15; John chapter 20 verses 10 to 23.

Christians believe that Jesus loves us and chose to take the blame for all the wrong things we have done by dying on the cross on Good Friday. God raised him back to life again on the Easter Sunday, and if we choose to follow him we can be forgiven.

Reflection

- What do you think about when you have to make a difficult choice? What influences that choice?
- Have you ever taken the blame for something you didn't do, or has someone else taken the blame for you? How did that make you feel?
- Think back to the story of the events of Easter in the sketch. What do you think is the most amazing thing that happened?

Strips of paper for each pupil to make a cross Pens, pencils, crayons












Easter Story wheel
